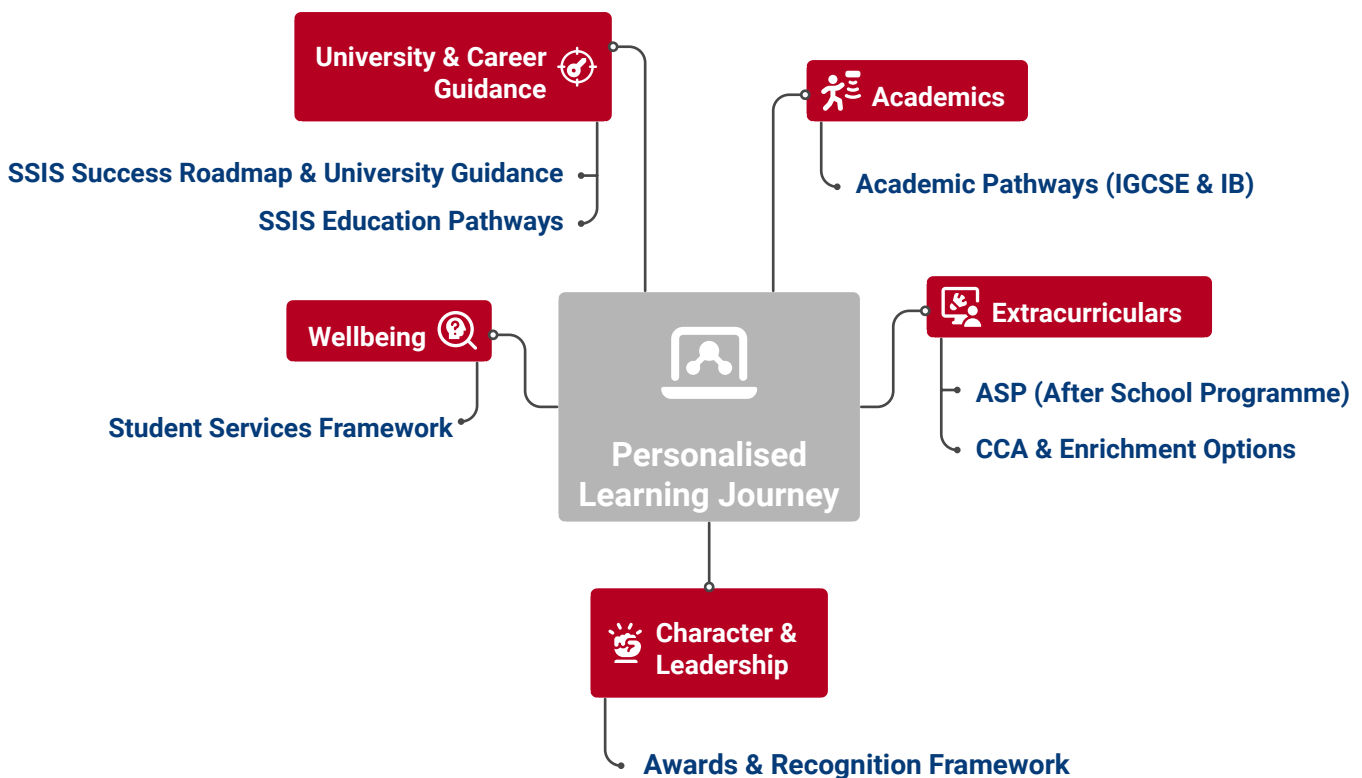
Theme 2: The Personalised Learning Journey – Bringing the Vision to Life for Every Child

Fee Schedule

Tuition Fees

- Tuition Fees for the Academic Year 2026/2027 will cover day-to-day tuition, the use of textbooks and library books, online educational resources, basic stationery and general educational materials.
- They also cover School-sponsored CCAs and ASPs, compulsory learning trips and educational visits (within Shanghai) and the technology fee for all grade levels.
- All students are entitled to complimentary daily school lunch.
- For external examination/test fees such as IGCSE, IB, AP, SAT, HSK, Cambridge English test etc., the respective payment details and deadlines will be shared in advance.
- For optional travel programmes outside of Shanghai or China, pricing and payment deadlines for trips will be published in advance of each trip.

Application Fee

The Application Fee is non-refundable, non-transferable and is only valid for the applying school year. This fee is due within 5 working days of its issuance.

Optional Services

• Bus Service Fee

The Transportation Fee applies only to those students who register with our regular bus service and should be paid in full before the school commencement date.

• English Language Acquisition (ELA) Programme

The English Language Acquisition (ELA) Programme (for Grade 1 to Grade 8 students only) provides additional support to students who require extra assistance to learn the English Language.

The year-long programme exits students at the end of the academic year. Payment should be made in full before the commencement of the service.

• Paid After-School Programme (ASP) Offerings and Fee

ASP is conducted after school from 3:30 to 4:50 p.m., Monday through Friday. We offer over 70 activities for our students, ranging from sports to interest clubs to academic support and student-led projects. To encourage students to join the ASP, most activities are complimentary and conducted by our teachers keen to share their expertise and guidance.

For paid ASPs, payment should be made in full before the commencement of the ASP session. Any outstanding fees will result in the student being unable to attend the ASP activities. ASP fees paid are non-transferable. No refunds will be given for missed session(s) due to personal reasons.

If the minimum required number of students is not met to start a class, all fees will be fully refunded.

A full refund will be given if a student withdraws from the paid ASP before the start of the ASP session. No refunds will be issued once the paid ASP starts.

Enrolment Fee and Refund Policy

1. Payment Schedule

The exchange rate is based on the central parity rate set by the People's Bank of China on the first working day of each month, where the received date of the overseas remittance shall prevail. Any differences in the amount due to exchange rates will be borne by the parents.

3. Discounts

• Sibling Discount

A 10% discount on the total annual tuition fee is offered to families enrolling two or more siblings.

• Corporate Discount

A 10% discount on the total annual tuition fee is offered to companies enrolling and paying for five or more children of their employees.

Note: Sibling and corporate discounts cannot be applied to the same student.

4. Late Payment Charges

A late payment fee of RMB 300 per day will be applied to overdue tuition fees, up to a maximum of 7 days. Payment of late payment charges will be issued with a school receipt only. After this period, the school reserves the right to:

- Suspend the student from attending classes.
- Withhold school reports, transcripts, or certificates.
- Offer the student's seat to new applicants on the waitlist.

5. Non-Payment of Fees

Once the school sends a final notice of overdue payment to parents, it becomes legally binding. If fees remain unpaid after the final notice, the school reserves the right to:

- Refuse re-enrolment for the following academic year.
- Suspend the student from school activities or classes until all outstanding fees and accrued late payment charges are settled.
- Offer the student's seat to new applicants on the waitlist.

6. Request for Withdrawal

To withdraw a student, parents must submit a written notice to the divisional principal office at least 30 days before the student's last day of school. Ensure you receive written acknowledgment of withdrawal from the school. Otherwise, students will be deemed as absent and these days of absence will be counted towards school days attended in a term.

If a student is expelled due to misconduct, no refund will be provided and all invoiced and unpaid fees will become payable to SSIS.

7. Refund Terms

Late Withdrawal Notice Surcharge: If a parent fails to notify the school of the intended withdrawal 30 days prior to the last day of school, then RMB 20,000 is deemed payable in lieu of notice.

Full Term Non-Attendance: If a student does not attend any school days in a term, the term's tuition will be refunded in full, less the Matriculation Fee, where applicable.

Partial Attendance: If a student attends any school day in a term, the full term's tuition is payable and non-refundable.

Annual Payment Discount: Any discounts applied for annual payments will be forfeited if the student withdraws mid-year.

8. Optional Services Refund Policy

• Transportation Fees

Refunds will be provided on a pro-rata basis, calculated per school day, less a RMB 400 handling fee. The amount per school day will be 1/180 of the fee for an academic year.

• English Language Acquisition (ELA) Programme

Fees for this programme are non-refundable and non-transferable.

• Paid After-School Programme

A full refund will be given if a student withdraws from the paid ASP before the start of the ASP session. No refunds will be issued once the paid ASP starts.

9. Fapiao (Tax Receipt)

A VAT E-Fapiao will be issued upon confirmation of fee payment. The remark column of the fapiao is blank by default. You may request details (e.g., Period of Study + Student Name) to be added to the fapiao.

Only one fapiao will be issued and the amount listed will be in accordance to the amount listed on the Proforma Invoice.

Note:

The matriculation fee, and other non-tuition fees are non-refundable.

Refunds will be processed after the student's last day of school.

Any overseas transaction fees for refunds must be borne by parents.

Refunds can only be made to the original payer.

Upon completion of the refund process, a revised E-Fapiao will be issued to parents. The original one will be canceled.

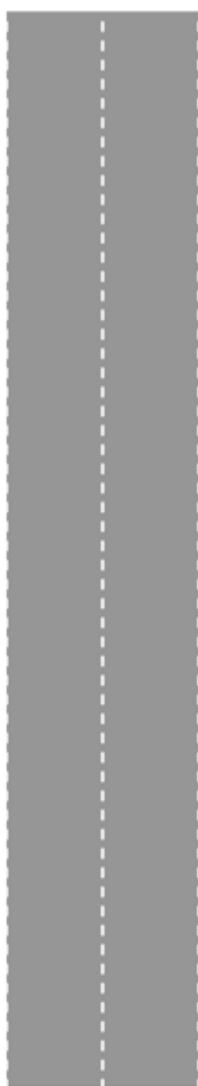

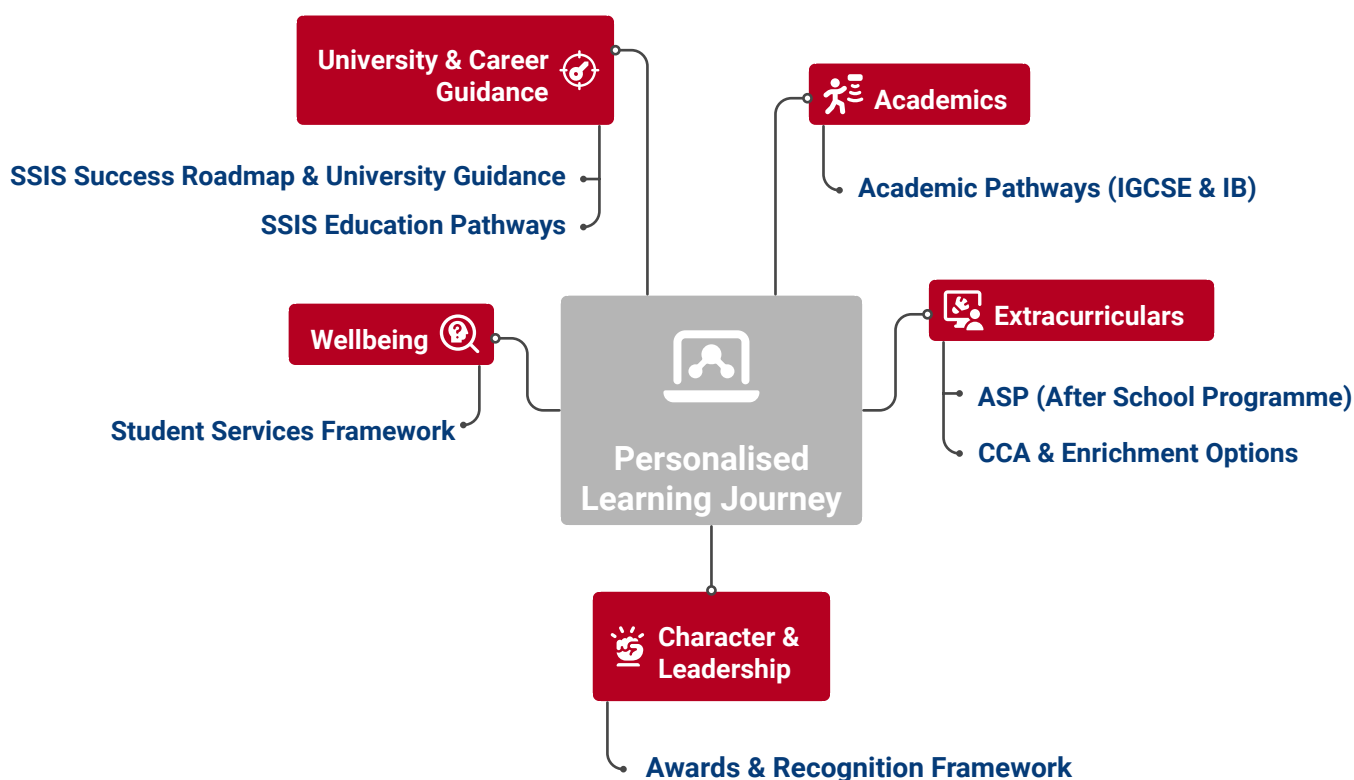
主题二：个性化学习旅程——让每个孩子的愿景成为现实

• 英语强化学习课程 (ELA)

• 课后活动课程 (ASP) 及收费类项目费用

课后活动课程 (ASPs) 于周一至周五下午 3:30 至 4:50 开展。我们为学生提供 70 多项活动，涵盖体育、兴趣俱乐部、学业辅导以及学生主导的课程等。为鼓励学生多多参与课后活动课程，大多数课程为免费项目 (除少数收费课程)，课程由满怀热忱、致力于分享专业知识并悉心提供指导的老师们授课。

收费类课后活动课程 (ASPs) 需在课程开始前完成全额付费。未付清费用的学员将无法参加 ASP 活动。已支付的 ASP 费用不可转让。因个人原因缺席课程，恕不退款。

若未达到开课所需的最低学生人数，课程费用将予以全额退还。

3. 折扣

• 家庭折扣

若同一家庭有两个或两个以上的孩子入读本校，每个孩子可享受学费百分之十(10%)的折扣。

• 公司折扣

若同一公司有五个或五个以上的员工子女入读本校，并由公司支付学费，每个孩子可享受学费百分之十(10%)的折扣。

注：同一个学生不能同时享有家庭折扣和公司折扣。

4. 逾期付费滞纳金

逾期缴纳的学费将被收取每天 300 元人民币的滞纳金，最多不超过 7 天。逾期付费的滞纳金将只出具学校的收据。超过此期限，学校保留以下权利：

- 学生停课。
- 拒绝提供学生报告、成绩单或证书。
- 将该学生的学位提供给候补名单上的申请者。

5. 未付费情况

一旦学校向家长发出逾期付款的最后通知，该通知即具有法律约束力。如在最后一次通知后仍未缴费，学校保留以下权利：

- 拒绝学生续读新学年。
- 学生会被停课并不得参加学校活动，直到所有未付费用和滞纳金全部付清。
- 将该学生的学位提供给候补名单上的申请者。

6. 退学申请

退学申请应在退学日期前至少30天，以书面形式通知学部校长，并确保您收到学校出具的书面退学确认。否则，学生将被视为缺席，缺席天数将被计入该学期的上学天数。

如果学生因行为不端而被开除，将不会享有任何退费，所有未支付的费用都应支付给学校。

7. 学费退费条款

逾期离校通知金：如果学生家长未能在退学日期前30天向学校提出退学申请，学校将收取人民币20,000元作为“逾期离校通知金”。

全学期缺勤：如果学生在一个学期中没有参加任何天数的学习，那么在扣除注册费后（如适用），该学期的学费将全额退还。

部分出勤：如果学生在一个学期中已参加任何一天的学习，那么该学期的学费应全额支付，且不予退还。

年付折扣：如果学生在当学年中途退学，任何年付折扣将被取消。

8. 可选服务退费政策

• 校车费

在学生退学时，已付校车费将根据当学年每个学日的费用比例计算退还，但要扣除400元的手续费。每个学日的费用将按当学年费用的一百八十分之一（1/180）来计算。

• 英语强化学习课程

此类课程项目费用不可退还、不可转让。

• 收费类课后活动课程

如果学生在付费类课后活动课程开始之日前提出退出申请，将给予全额退款。从付费类课后活动课程开始之日起，该课程的费用均不予退还。

9. 发票（税票）细则

增值税普通电子发票将在确认收到相关费用后开具。发票的备注栏默认为空白，可以要求注明：学习期间+学生姓名。

每份收费通知只能开具一张发票，且发票所列金额与收费通知上的金额须一致。

注：注册费和其他非学费类费用不可退还。

退费将在学生最后上课日之后处理。

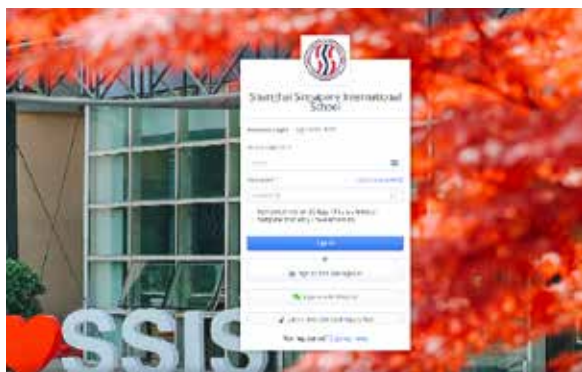

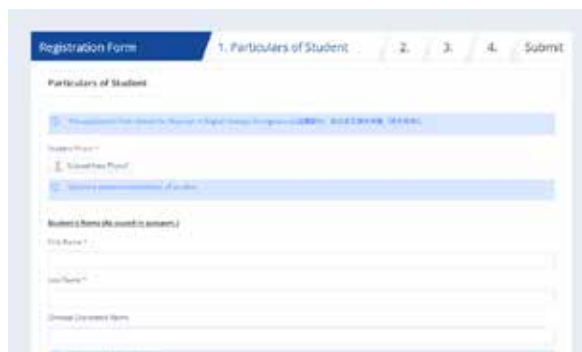
