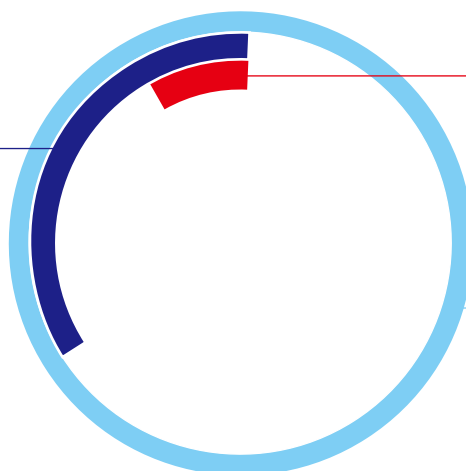

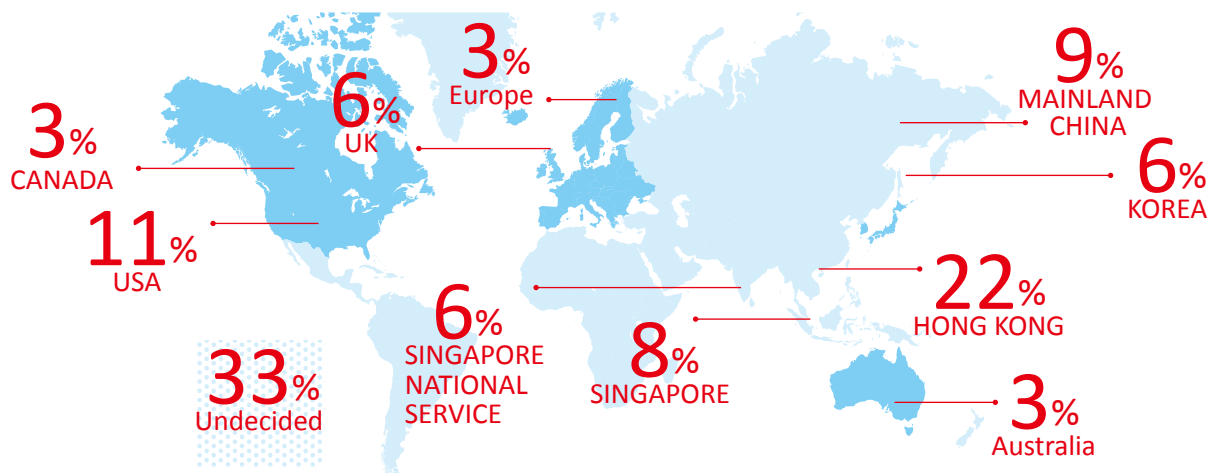

ASSESSMENTS AND RANKINGS

Shanghai Singapore International School does not provide class rank, nor does it compute cumulative GPAs. Universities are encouraged to base their admission decision on the student's transcript, IGCSE exam grades and IB Predicted Grades.

IGCSE: Formal narrative reports are sent home three times per year, in November/December, March/April and June. Assessments in the school-based curriculum and the IGCSE are based on marks which correspond to a grade ranking from A*- G. Candidates who do not obtain enough marks for a G grade will be ungraded.

IB: Formal narrative reports are sent home three times per year, in November/December, March/April and June. Starting in Grade 11, all Shanghai Singapore International School students are enrolled in the 2-year IB Diploma program.
