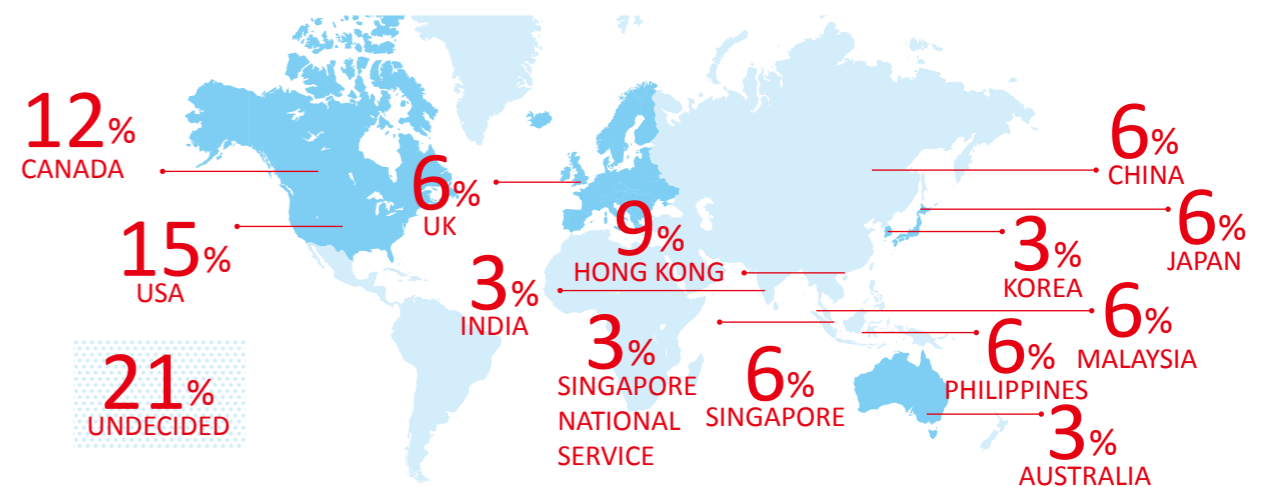

MATRICULATION – CLASS OF 2020

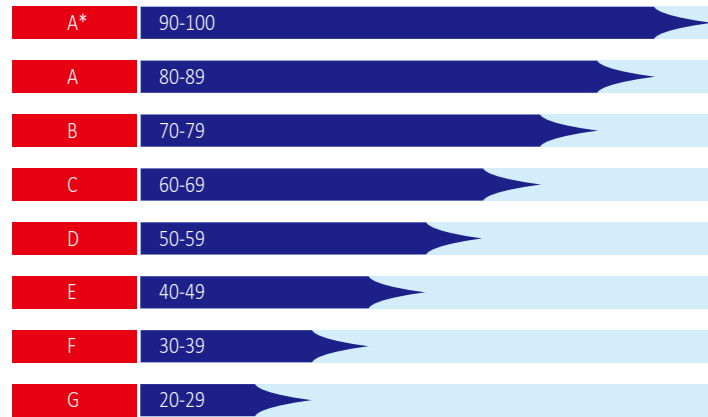

ASSESSMENT AND RANKING

Formal narrative reports are sent home three times per year, in November, February and June. Assessments in the school-based curriculum and the IGCSE are based on marks which correspond to a grade ranking from A* - G. Candidates who do not obtain enough marks for a G grade will be ungraded.



IB subjects are graded on a 1 to 7 scale, with 1 being lowest and 7 being outstanding.

Due to COVID 19, current Grade 10 and 12 End of Year Exams were held in September of 2020. This grade represents the summative result of work covered in the 2019-2020 Academic year, and has been entered as the End of Year Exam for 2019-2020 on transcript.

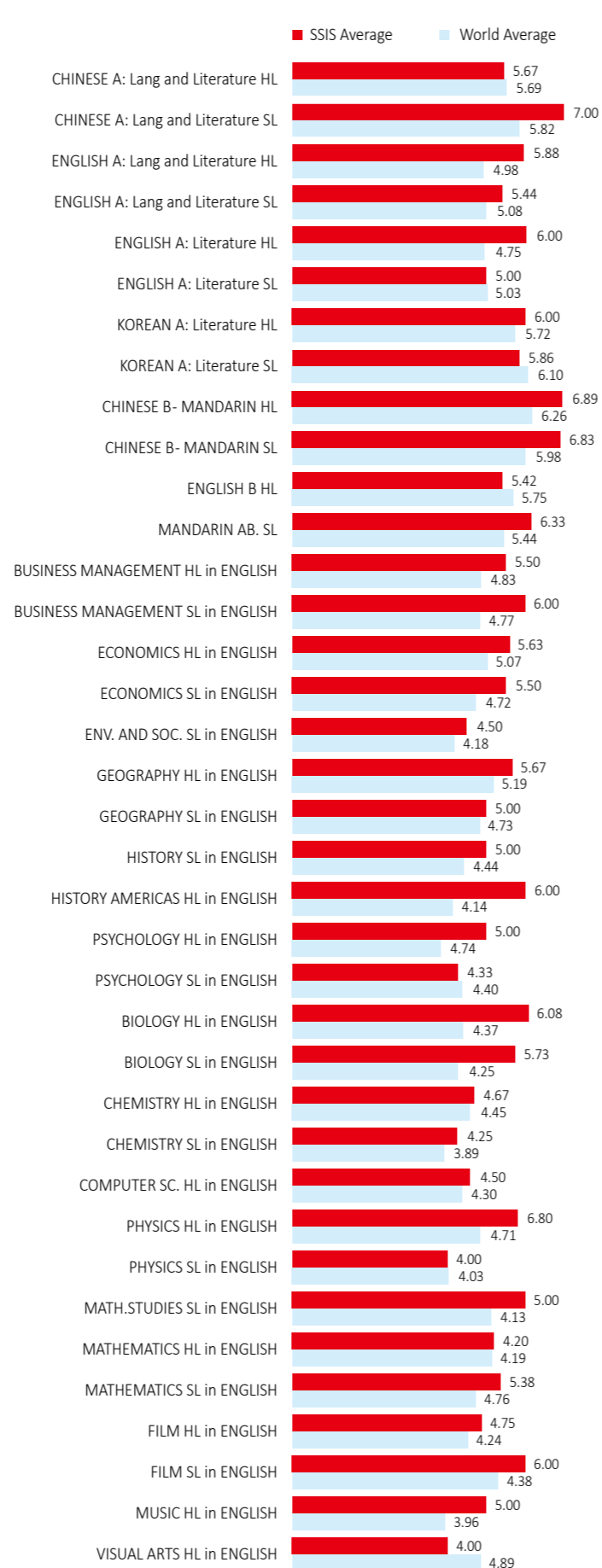
