INTRODUCTION

SSIS celebrates more than two decades of excellence and anticipates more successes in the years ahead. The school wants to recognize our students' relentless effort in living up to the School Motto of "Strive for Excellence".

We are pleased to offer the SSIS Technology and Innovation Scholarship to students.

RECIPIENTS

The SSIS Technology and Innovation Scholarship, which pays 50% tuition fee will be awarded to one student on a merit basis. The Scholarship is renewable at the end of each academic year based on the maintenance of high technology achievement in representing SSIS and community involvement.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Consistent initiative in purposeful, collaborative application of technology and/or innovation to create lasting beneficial solutions, tools, program, system, activity, or service for school, community, society
- Passion and commitment towards accomplishing goals
- Evidence of awards, leadership recognition or outstanding results.
- Good academic results across a range of subjects. All results should be C or above.
- Quality of communication during interviews.
- Being in excellent standing in the SSIS Community.
- The areas of technology to be considered for the SSIS Technology & Innovation Scholarship will be decided by the school.
- Additional awards may be made at any time at the discretion of the school.
- Ability to represent SSIS in and outside of school
- No discipline record



TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Scholarships are renewable at the end of each academic year based on the maintenance of high achievements in the identified field when representing SSIS.
- The scholarship is available to new and existing students at Shanghai Singapore International School (SSIS).
- Should the scholarship holder leave SSIS before successful completion of the academic year, the full school fees for the academic year must be repaid to the school.
- The scholarship cannot be held concurrently with any other award or scholarship without the prior written approval of SSIS.
- Scholarships recipients will cover the costs of any incidentals incurred during competitions.
- The scholarship can be revoked:
 - At any time the school determines that the application included false statements.
 - If the student fails to uphold the commitment to excellence or integrity expected of a recipient.
 - If the student fails to attend and represent at relevant individual or team competitions.
 - Should the above happen, at least one formal warning in writing will be given to the student and the parents prior to the withdrawal of the scholarship. In case of extreme disciplinary measures, the scholarship may be revoked without any prior written notification.
- Nearing the end of each academic year, scholarship holders will be required to submit the Scholarship Renewal outlining their contribution to the school and highlighting their achievements in the area of technology and innovation identified to ensure the continuation of the scholarship.
- Decisions made by the Scholarship Committee are final and specific questions with regards to the rationale of decisions made will not be entertained.
- The School Board reserves the right to vary the terms and conditions of the Scholarship without prior notice.



APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Scholarship applications by currently enrolled SSIS students must be fully completed and submitted by the published deadline.
- Student applying as a new enrolment to SSIS may apply for a scholarship prior to enrolment.
- A copy of previous school reports, certificates, awards and/or transcripts must be submitted for new and existing SSIS students.
- Fully completed scholarship application form.
- Two Teacher, Director of Technology or Principal recommendation forms for new and existing SSIS students
- A personal statement (essay)
- Shortlisted students will be invited to attend an interview.
- Scholarship holders will be informed in writing.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

All SSIS students will receive information from SSIS regarding scholarship information and submission deadline. This information will also be made available on our school website.

Candidates must complete the following process:

- Complete the application form which can be found on the school website.
- Submit a copy of current school reports, certificates, award and/or transcripts for new and existing SSIS students.
- Attach the required personal statement (essay), completed in the student's own words.
- Two Teacher, Director of Technology or Principal recommendation forms for new and existing SSIS students
- Submit additional portfolio/documentation. (eg. External Prizes and Awards, Leadership recognition etc.)

SCHOLARSHIP RENEWAL

- Scholarship holders who achieve excellence in the area of technology and innovation identified at the end of the academic year are eligible to request the renewal of their scholarship in the next academic year.
- The Scholarship Recipient Report has to be submitted to the Director of Technology/ Divisional Principal.
- The current scholarship holder has to submit/upload the renewal form before the published dates.
- The scholarship holders will be informed on the status of their scholarship renewal on the last school day.

THE PERSONAL STATEMENT (ESSAY)

This section allows students to express in writing his/her own views about the topic. The length of the essay is to be confined to one A4 sheet, double-spaced, 12-point font size and must be written personally by the student.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

Additional information, certificates, awards, performance results or testimonials will be accepted. Please clearly label all supporting documents with the applicant's full name. These will be returned, if requested.

TEACHER OR PRINCIPAL RECOMMENDATION LETTER

Two (2) recommendation forms are required from a current teacher or principal.
